American Badger


Continent: North America

European Badger


Continent: Europe

Habitat: Forests and woodlands

What It Eats: Worms, insects, fruits, plants

Body Clues: Round body, fluffy fur,
black-and-white face stripes

Special Trait: Lives in family groups



Honey Badger

Continent: Africa

Habitat: Grasslands, forests

What It Eats: Honey, insects, small animals

Body Clues: Thick skin, strong body,
light back stripe

Special Trait: Fearless behavior
